

# Parent's Pledge

1. I realize that attending Grace Christian Academy is a privilege and not a right.
2. I recognize that Grace Christian Academy has a qualified staff and I have confidence in their ability to educate my child.
3. I agree to accept all regulations of the school in the applicant's behalf.
4. I give permission for my child to take part in all Academy activities, including sports and Academy-sponsored trips away from the Academy premises, and absolve the Academy from liability to me or my child because of any injury to my child at the Academy or during any Academy activity.
5. I pledge to pay my financial obligations to the Grace Christian Academy on the date due.
6. I understand that if my child should be withdrawn by the parent or administration, the current semester's charges will continue through the end of the semester that he/she is withdrawn.
7. I understand that Grace Christian Academy reserves the right to expel any child who fails to comply with the established regulations and discipline or whose financial obligation remains unpaid.
8. I agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of Grace Christian Academy by providing a place at home for my child to study and to give my child encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.
9. I understand that the standards of Grace Christian Academy do not tolerate profanity; obscenity in word or action; the possession or use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco at home or anywhere in the community; or disrespect to the personnel of the school.
10. I understand that the Academy expects regular weekly church attendance on the part of all students and I agree to comply with this.
11. I understand the Academy's dress code as stated in the Grace Christian Academy Handbook and will observe my children carefully in this matter.
12. I will undertake volunteer duties and responsibilities for Grace Christian Academy as opportunities arise and as God provides time and strength.
13. I realize that from time to time children take issue with actions that they do not agree with and are prone to criticize statements out of context. Such actions being normal for children, I pledge that should such occur, I will support the Academy personnel and not accept the criticism. If I have a question concerning an incident, I will call the Academy for full details and then take corrective action with my child. If I am still unable to resolve my concerns, I will then quietly withdraw my child and I will not spread criticism.
14. I will make it a policy never to criticize the Academy or disagree with Academy policies in front of my children.
15. I will seek the advancement of Grace Baptist Church and Grace Christian Academy in all areas: spiritually, academically, and physically.
16. I have read the G.C.A. Handbook.
17. I have read the Statement of Faith and objectives and **subscribe** to them.
18. I agree and consent that my child's photograph may be used for promotional, publicity, or website purposes.
